Industrial Action by the National Education Union

Many of you will have heard that the National Education Union announced this week that their members have voted for strike action. The vast majority of the teaching staff at Hitherfield are members of the National Education Union and therefore it is highly likely that the usual running of the school will be heavily impacted if the strikes go ahead.

The dates of the proposed strike action that will impact Hitherfield and other London schools are:

- Wednesday 1st February 2023
- Thursday 2nd March 2023
- Wednesday 15th March 2023
- Thursday 16th March 2023

At this stage we are awaiting further guidance on what we will be able to offer in terms of on-site and virtual education on those days. We will write to everyone as soon as we know. In the meantime, we recommend that parents and carers look into alternative childcare options for those dates and inform their employers of potential disruption.

- If your child is absent, you will need to contact the office by 9am. You can call and leave a message on 020 8769 8428 or email admin@hitherfield.co.uk
- If your child has vomiting or has diarrhoea then they must stay at home for 48 hours since the last episode.
- If you need to request time off school then you will need to complete and absence request form which you can find on our website or in the main office.
- If your child has any medicine in the school e.g. asthma inhaler or epipen, it is the parents responsibility to make sure these are in date. We will contact you if anything runs out.


