Applying for a primary school place for 2024-25

If your child was born between 1 September 2019 and 31 August 2020, you must apply for a primary or infant school place for September 2024.

The deadline for on-time applications was midnight on Monday 15 January 2024. If you have not applied already, you still need to do so online for your child to start primary school in September 2024.
