## Birthday Celebrations...

We know that many families want to share their child's Birthday celebrations with the other children in their class. Now that we are all able to use the school site in our usual way we are able to return to our original arrangement for sharing Birthday cakes. If you wish to bring in cakes to celebrate your child's Birthday, the arrangements are as follows:

- Parents/carers will be responsible for sharing a cupcake, slice of cake or a biscuit/cookie with the children in your child's class at the end of the school day. You will need to meet your child and their class in their area of the playground and distribute these yourself. Children (especially the younger ones) can then check with the grown-up collecting them if they can eat the cake/cookie.
- Please check with the office if you wish to know the exact number of children you need to cater for but there are no more than 30 children in any class.
- If your child attends the After School Club, they should bring the cakes in a suitable container clearly labelled with your child's name and class to the office at the beginning of the day. **Sorry, but we will not be able to accept large cakes that need to be cut up.** If you send these in, they will be returned to you which will be extremely sad for your child.

If you are not happy for your child to be given a cake, please make sure that you instruct them to say "No thank you," when this is offered to them.

## Flu Vaccination Programme

The NHS nurses will be coming in on Tuesday 7th December to vaccinate any children who's parents have completed the online consent form. Children **WILL NOT** be vaccinated if the NHS have not received a consent form or no consent was given.

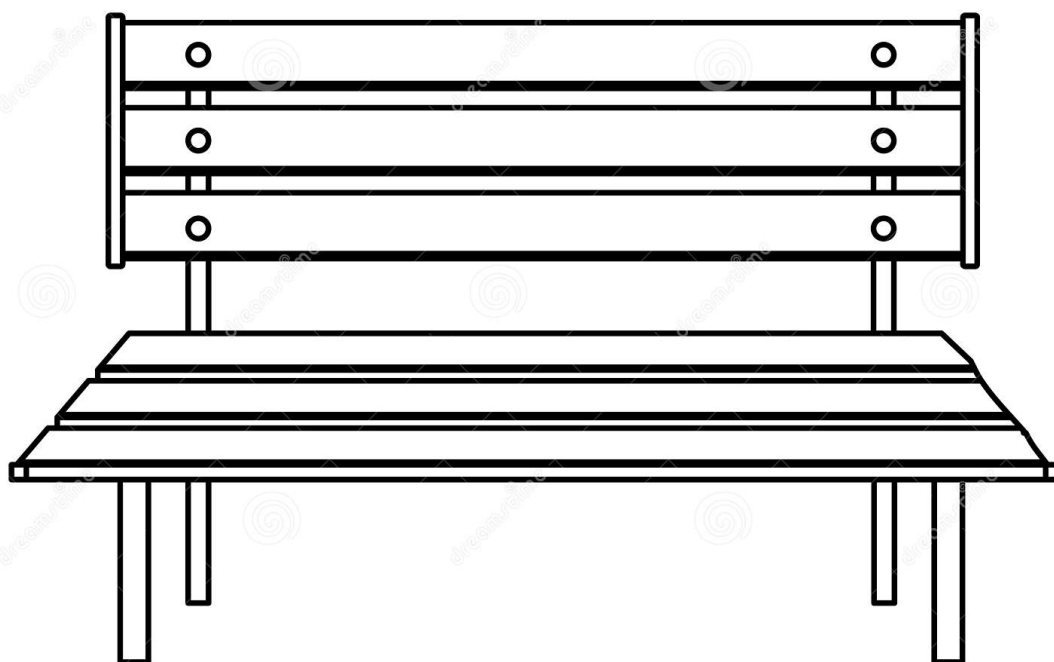

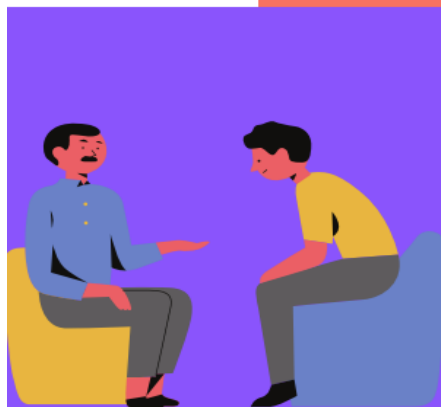
