
She was a kind and considerate person and she made medicine out of plants and herbs. She learnt from her mum because she also helped sick soldiers.


She was an inspiration because she helped other people even though other people didn't always help her.

Nanny of the Maroons

Nanny was born in the 1680s in Ghana. She was brought to Jamaica as an enslaved person. She escaped being an enslaved person and became a Maroon. Nanny became a leader of a Maroon settlement. The British attacked the maroons and in 1740 the British gave up because the Maroons were too strong. They used guerrilla warfare to stop the British. Nanny is on a \$500 note in Jamaica today. We celebrated her by painting a watercolour background for her portrait and recreating her head scarf and clothing using collage.

All requests and sponsors will be kept private and confidential.




















ORDER YOUR CHRISTMAS TREE WITH HITHERIFLED PTA & HELP RAISE FUNDS FOR THE SCHOOL
