When is Day 5 of isolation?

The current Covid rules state that it is possible to take Lateral flow tests on Days 5 and 6 and, if they are negative, isolation can end and children and adults can return to school or work. There has been some confusion over when Day 1 of isolation starts and, in turn, when Days 5 and 6 are. As can be seen in the diagram below, Day 1 is the day after a positive test or symptoms starting.

What if the test on Days 5 or 6 are positive?

The first test must be taken no earlier than day 5 of the self-isolation period, and the second must be taken the following day. If an individual is positive on day 5, then a negative test is required on day 6 and day 7 to release from isolation. It is essential that 2 negative rapid lateral flow tests are taken on consecutive days and reported before individuals return to their job or school, if leaving self-isolation earlier than the full 10-day period. For instance, if an individual is positive on day 5, then a negative test is required on both day 6 and day 7 to release from self-isolation, or positive on day 6, then a negative test is required on days 7 and 8, and so on until the end of day 10.

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


What's this? A celebrity? At Hitherfield Primary
