

### Changing between sibling accounts on Seesaw

Dear Parents and Carers,

Several of you with more than one child at Hitherfield have asked whether it is possible to change between their accounts without logging out. Unfortunately, this currently isn't possible. We would recommend either:


• having both QR codes somewhere easily accessible so that you can logout from one account and login to the other as quickly as possible.

or

using the alphabetical codes to login rather than the QR codes. The alphabetical code, which is at the bottom of your child's Seesaw sign-in sheet, comprises 16 letters and looks like this when you login:



When you have typed the codes in once, you could then save them on your device e.g. through Google's password saver. You could then switch between them without having to type them in again by hovering over the password field like this and clicking on the code you want to use:



If you have lost the sign-in sheet, which lists both your child's QR code and alphabetical code, then please ask for a replacement from the school office team.

The Lambeth Autism Advisory Service are very pleased to resume their parent workshops.

These workshops are for families in Lambeth who have an autistic child, or those who on are on the pathway to obtaining a diagnosis.

#### The session will take place on Wednesday 23rd November at 10:00am – 11:30am

#### Rosendale Primary School have kindly offered to host this session.

The first session, Understanding Autism and Strategies will cover the following areas:

- What does an autism diagnosis look like?
- Focus on differences not deficits.
- Consider how we can change to acknowledge difference as social partners and parents.
- · Allow families time to reflect on their understanding of their child's diagnosis
- Explore a range of strategies to support language, emotional regulation & understanding and communication & interaction.
- Learn how to support the development of skills for learning and independence.
