Happy Easter


I wish everyone a good Easter holiday. It looks like we starting the holiday with some fine weather which hopefully means everyone can get out and about in the sunshine.

SPRING TERM COMMUNITY CLINICS

To ensure every child is protected, the school-age immunisation service is offering extra vaccination clinics at trusted local community centres. These clinics are for children who missed their in-school vaccinations and need to catch up on the following:

- **DTP** (3-in-1 teenage booster) – protects against tetanus, diphtheria and polio
- **MenACWY** – protects against Meningococcal groups A, C, W and Y.
- **HPV** – protects against cancers and genital warts caused by specific human papillomavirus (HPV) types
- **MMR** – protects against measles, mumps and rubella.

These are **walk-in clinics**, so no appointment is needed.
