A special thanks to Lois and her children Jude and Stevie, who took all the leftover cakes and sold them on their street the day after the Fair, so nothing went to waste!









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
Oasis St Martin's

A brand new session that is on a Tuesday evening 5-6pm nearby at Oasis St Martins (formerly St Martins in the Field).

The session is part of Play Like a Girl programme which is a programme designed for girls of all abilities. Whether they've never kicked a ball before or whether they already have some experience. We offer safe spaces for girls only where they can come and be themselves and learn the game. With this particular programme we focus on the social side of the sport and teaching key life skills.

Another big part of what we do is try to make football accessible to all. Sessions are priced at £6 per session and there is no level of commitment required. Parents only pay for the sessions they intend to attend. But also we know the struggle that people have and the cost of living so we also offer our discounted membership. This is a short application process where parents can either pay what they can afford or just cover an admin fee of £1 which then covers their young player the season.

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


