Volunteers Needed to Help Rebuild Our Edible Garden

Do you have a cordless electric drill/screwdriver and are handy?

Or just eager to lend a hand?

As we know money is tight with the school cuts, so it has been hard to find the budget to fix the damaged raised beds. Because they are made of untreated wood (to avoid harmful leaching of chemicals into the soil where we grow food) the beds and borders have needed replacing every few years.

We've come up with a new plan! The PTA have funded the purchase of recycled plastic lumber from British Recycled Plastic, a company that take British plastic and recycle it in 3 UK locations into plastic wood. It removes plastic waste from UK landfill, is made specifically so that it does not leach chemicals into the soil and has a 25 year guarantee.

YOUR SCHOOL NEEDS YOU!

Can **YOU** be a Hitherfield Hero reading volunteer?

For the past few years, we have had incredible success with our Hitherfield Hero reading programme, ensuring every class in the school has had a volunteer reader from the community at least once a week! This had an incredible impact on our readers and we want to do that again next year (starting September 2025)!

We are calling on anyone who is able to donate at least 30 minutes a week of their time to the school (either 9-9.30am or 3-3.30pm) to help target children learn to read.

In each class, from Reception to Year 6, there are children who need **YOUR** help to maximise their progress.

You would be assigned a class, and listen to three children read once a week on a day to suit you. This one-to-one reading has an incredible impact - just five minutes reading a day can make a huge difference to fluency and comprehension!

Sadly, with the cuts to education funding, the school has less and less staff in order to achieve this targeted, often one-on-one, support. This is why we need **YOU**!

Dear Parent/Carer

I'm delighted to let you know that this summer Lambeth Council will be hosting our Holiday Activities and Food Programme.

We are partnering with local holiday club providers across the borough to provide an exciting programme of meals and activities for children and young people in our local communities. Free places are available for children between the ages of 4 and 16 years, who are eligible for benefits-related school meals.

The programme will run from **Monday 28 July to Friday 29 August 2025** and is designed to give local families on benefits-related free school meals access to free, healthy food and fun activities over the summer holidays. Each programme will provide:

- Free, healthy, and tasty food
- Fun physical activity sessions
- A wide range of other activities to suit different ages and personalities
- Opportunities to learn more about food and nutrition for children and families

This year we are introducing a new way to book with providers. We are using a booking system called Eequ. You will be able to book up to 16 sessions per eligible child, with all 60+ providers in Lambeth, from Friday 27 June at 8am. You are able to visit the platform from today and register your interest in activities, but the full range of activities on offer may not be available until 27th June at 8am.

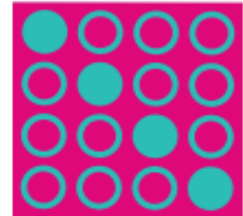
