The kids now have much more space to grow in and these beds, made from recycled plastic (from British Recycled Plastic if you want to know more about what we used), should last at least 25 years.

We were very pleased to find lots of interesting wildlife hidden away, including toads, absolutely massive stag beetle grubs and plenty of ants. It's a great sign of a healthy garden.

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




