EDUCATIONAL VISITS/WORKSHOPS

At Hitherfield we arrange for all children to attend a number of educational visits throughout the academic year as they are an excellent way to expand learning opportunities and take learning beyond the classroom! We also have a range of visitors to the school, who perform or run workshops with the children.

We would like to thank all parents and carers for their valuable support in the past as without your financial contributions we would not be able to organise and pay for the learning experiences our children have enjoyed. **Thank you!**

WE NEED YOUR SUPPORT


