From Everyone at Hitherfield, we wish you a very Happy New Year!

Volunteering 9am - 10am Thursdays

Yes, the weather is cold but Jessi is still ready to welcome you, on Thursday mornings, into the edible garden. This half term will be focused around pruning our apples, pears, cherries, currants and gooseberries. We will be reusing as much as we can for cuttings. Pop in for a session or two and get hands on experience with pruning and propagating. You can see what kind of edibles we grow around the school and how your children get involved. Pick up new skills and ideas on how to grow your own. No previous experience or knowledge is necessary.

Also, a reminder that **Children are welcome in the edible garden only when supervised by an adult** before and after school. We ask that the adults ensure that the children are respectful to the garden, only picking what is ready and what they are going to eat, so nothing is wasted.

Friday's morning adult sessions will resume after the half term.

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
