Dear Mums, Dads and Carers,

Happy New Year to you all from the Streatham and Norwood Better Start Team!

We hope you all enjoyed a safe, happy and restful Christmas break and are looking forward to starting a new term with us. Our new timetable will provide you with all the information you need about our services, forthcoming groups and activities.

The booking system remains in place, so please do call one day in advance and speak to a member

of the Administration Team to book your place in any of your chosen activity sessions.

We are hosting ESOL courses again this term, facilitated by High Trees Community Development Trust. A free crèche is available, but places are limited, so please book early to avoid disappointment. Please call to speak with one of the Administrators at either Bentons Lane Children's Centre (020 4542 3520), Hitherfield Children's Centre (0208 835 9569) to book your place.

New activities include Circle of Security, Baby Massage and Making it REAL. Please see the timetable or respective flyers in your nearest Children's Centre for more information.

Chat and Play meetings with a Better Start Worker will also be available by appointment onsite if you wish to discuss a specific issue in confidence. Should you need advice regarding employment, careers or training, housing, finance, or immigration status, for example, please and speak to one of our Administrators who will be pleased to make an appointment for you.

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We are all very pleased that in spite of the ongoing issues relating to the Covid 19 pandemic term we have been able to stay open and sustain the delivery of service to you. We therefore appreciate your support and cooperation in helping us to establish and maintain a safe environment for children and families.

We are now all required to wear a face mask or face covering while in public spaces indoors. We therefore ask that you are prepared, remembering to bring a face mask with you to wear for the duration of the session when you come to the

Children's Centre. You do not need to wear a mask when using the outdoor space with your children. We do ask that you maintain social distancing as much as possible. We also recommend that on arrival and departure from the building and during your visit, you take every opportunity to wash your hands and/or use the hand sanitisers that are readily available. We do have a limited number of small bottles of hand sanitiser. If you would like one please come to the Children's Centre office to collect on a first come first serve basis.

Please remember to let us know if you have developed symptoms of Covid 19 or have been in close contact with someone who has tested positive for the Covid 19 or indeed Omicron, which is the new variant. We also ask that you do not visit the centre if you, your child or anyone in your household have symptoms of Covid 19. Children or adults who appear to have symptoms of Covid 19 will be advised to leave the centre and seek immediate medical advice and attention.

I would like to thank you once again for your continued cooperation and support in this.

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FareShare: From January 2022 the Hitherfield Children's Centre site will cease to be an official distributor on behalf of FareShare. Since the beginning of the first lockdown, we have been pleased to support the Felix Project, a charity organisation who save good food from going to waste, redistributing it to 224 charities and community groups across the capital, including Children's Centres, to ensure that the food they have collected is made available to families in need. We feel that since the position for has now changed, it is more productive to review individual needs more closely and ensure that we provide a pertinent response.

Parent Satisfaction Survey: I would like to thank all those who took the time to participate in the Lambeth Parent Satisfaction Survey. We are committed to providing the best possible service to local children and families. Understanding your views and opinions about our services will help us to ensure that our services respond to and reflect the changing needs of the community. Going forward I would like to create a forum where we are able to evaluate our services together on a more regular basis. The new term will see the re-establishment of the Children's Centre User Forum. We will meet initially once each half term to share and discuss our experiences of using the Better Start Services in Streatham and Norwood. I am seeking to have an established group of parents and carers who will represent the views of local families in the community at each forum. There will be more information in the New Year, but if you are interested in being part of the forum, please come to see me. The date of the first forum meeting is Wednesday 16th February at 10:00am at Hitherfield Children's Centre.

Streatham Hub: Unfortunately, we had to suspend the delivery of services at Streatham Hub for health and safety reasons. We have been working closely with Lambeth and the Board of Trustees at the Streatham United Reformed Church to resolve these issues and are looking forward to resuming activities from the week beginning 24th January. Scheduled activities for The Hub will

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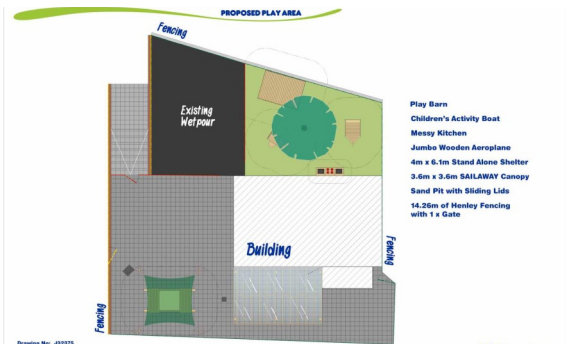
take place on Mondays at Sunnyhill Children's Centre and Tuesdays at Hitherfield Children's Centre.

Site Developments: Later this term we are planning to undertake work to improve the outdoor space at Hillside Gardens to increase the potential of how we can use the space to provide positive learning experiences for children and families. We hope to start in March and seek to keep disruption to a minimum. We hope you will understand that for safety reasons, the site will be closed while the work is being done; some sessions may be

cancelled or relocated, so please bear with us during that time. We will keep you updated on the progress nearer the time. We are excited about the project and look forward to its completion and the opportunity to offer a wider range of outdoor play experiences for children and families.

Fundraising and Charity Support: We did have some outstanding items from those donated to support Afghanistan refugees. We were able to distribute these items between St Michael's Fellowship and Brixton and Norwood Foodbank; two fantastic charity organisations with whom we work closely to provide essential support to local families in need.

Childminders Group: We established a designated session for Childminders and professional childcare providers at the beginning of last term. This has proved popular and we are now seeking to consult with them and with the Local Authority to clarify expectations and ensure that we are effective in supporting the ongoing professional development of local childminders and the care they provide for children. Tracy Lattimore, Deputy Manager for Early Years will facilitate the group at Hillside Gardens every Wednesday morning from 9.30 – 11.30, starting on 12th January. 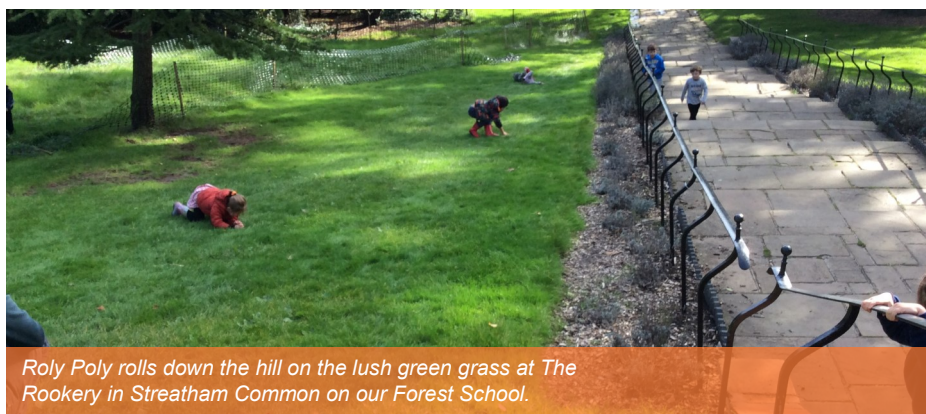

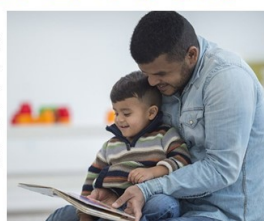
