Serious Incident on Leigham Court Road

There was a serious incident on Leigham Court Road that involved local secondary pupils being hurt. Thankfully we have heard that the victims are going to be okay. The incident happened at 3:23pm on Wednesday 25th November. The suspect was arrested and crime scenes were started in Leigham Court Road and Culver House Gardens and remain in place while the initial stages of the investigation progresses.

Police believe this to be an isolated incident and neighbourhood officers will be providing visible reassurance patrols at the local secondary school.

The Community Safety team are keen to ensure the local community has the emotional and mental support needed to deal with this incident, and Lambeth Council has services available for anyone who feels affected by this attack, or the wider issue of violence in our communities.
