

Hitherfield is taking part in the Sustrans Big Pedal 2021 – the UK's largest inter-school cycling, walking, wheeling, and scooting competition. Cycling journeys, scooter journeys, walking journeys and journeys made by wheelchair all count equally in the Sustrans Big Pedal challenge. Due to the impact of coronavirus, pupils who are taught remotely can record an active journey with a family member from home or 30 minutes of physical activity instead. Hitherfield has entered into the 5-day challenge starting Monday 26th April until Friday 30th April 2021.

Schools will be entered into daily prize draws for rewards if pupils' cycle, walk, wheel or scoot each day of the challenge. Prizes up for grabs include accessories and equipment to help the school travel actively.

The top 5 schools with the greatest number of pupils taking part in the challenge will receive an exclusive framed Big Pedal 2021 certificate.

There are also prizes for families in the Sustrans Big Pedal family competition on social media. The competition gives parents and guardians the chance to win one of three amazing prizes for their family. All families need to do is take a photo or a short video of their child(ren) taking part in Big Pedal between 19-30 April. Post it to Instagram, Facebook or Twitter, tag @Sustrans and use #BigPedalWin.
