FORMS/INFORMATION NEEDED

- 1. Emergency contact details
- 2. Medical information please complete this and bring on the day along with relevant medication. Tania will be responsible for any medication. Calpol will be taken but will only be given if you have completed the permission to administer medicine
- 3. Dietary requirements/allergies
- 4. Swimming ability
- 5. Twitter teachers will be posting photos each day of the activities the children have enjoyed. Please can you let Tania in the office know if you DO NOT consent to photos of your child and posted on Twitter
- 6. Please let the teachers know if there is anything personal about your child which may cause anxiety or worry for them (eg sleeping issues/toileting). This will help us with deciding which room they are going to be placed in.

CODE OF CONDUCT/RULES FOR THE WEEK

- No electronic devices are to be brought
- No cameras unless they are disposable
- Children will not be able to phone home. If there is an emergency staff will call parents/carers
- Children are supervised at all times. Once lights are out they must stay in their rooms and will be monitored by the school adults who are on each floor
- Children are expected to follow the same rules/expectations of behaviour as when at school. Any incidents may result in missing activities as a sanction
- No extra food to be brought (or smuggled into cases!) There will be ample food provided.
- School will send out texts to let you know that the children have arrived safely and keep you updated during the week. Please ensure the office have the correct mobile number for you!

ROOM ALLOCATIONS

- These will be done by the adults going on school journey
- Friendship groups will be taken into consideration when assigning rooms to ensure the children feel happy and settled

LFD testing

We ask that you test your children on the Sunday before departure -if your child tests positive you must follow the guidelines for isolation

If a child presents as unwell during the week, in consultation with parents, we may LFD test

As with any illness, children might need to return home. This will be done in consultation with parents.

Chris will be staying on the Tuesday/Wednesday. If needed he will be able to return children to school

Advice from Lambeth and National Heath England will be sought if needed.
