#### Start / End of day Timings and Entrances:

Pedestrian and vehicle gates will be open from 8:45am to prevent bottlenecks.

Parents/carers are permitted onto the school site provided they wear a mask at all times unless they are exempt and they . Parents are not permitted to enter the school buildings apart from the main school office. There is a limit of two visitors at a time in the main school office and all adults entering the office will need to wear masks unless exempt.

If parents/carers are dropping off or collecting more than one child they can use either entrance and they can remain on site whilst waiting for the later drop off or collection. They must keep their child/ren close to them and maintain a social, 2m, distance from others.

Once the last child is collected parents/carers must leave the school site as quickly as possible.

At the start and end of the day each Reception class will be dropped off/collected at a designated area to be collected by their parents/carers.

Koala class - from the area opposite the blue side door into the Reception building next to the bike/scooter park area.

Platypus class - from the Reception outdoor area outside the main entrance to the Reception building.

Kookaburra class will be collected from the outdoor area next to the climbing frame.

Parents/carers to drop off and collect from the balcony gate using the one way system. Parents/carers will walk to the drop off point on their left hand side and keep to their left hand side as they walk away from the drop off point at the balcony gate.
